4. **She compares him to other men** [10]. This can involve comparing him to friends, ex-boyfriends, or even celebrities, which is damaging and makes him feel inadequate and like a failure [10, 11]. Licensed therapist John Kim explains that constant comparisons place unfair pressure on the relationship [11].
5. **She stops listening to him** [12]. When she disregards his attempts to communicate his feelings, he will feel undervalued, frustrated, and disconnected, leading to one-sided conversations [12, 13]. Psychologist Cara Gardenswartz emphasizes that effective communication, including deliberate listening, is the cornerstone of any successful relationship [13].
6. **She gossips about his quirks** [14]. What she once found endearing, she now discusses with friends, making his unique traits seem like a burden. This shows a loss of respect for him in both public and private, eroding his self-esteem and the feeling of safety in the marriage [14, 15].
7. **She constantly brings up his past mistakes** [16]. Despite having forgiven him, bringing up old grievances suggests she doesn't value him in the same way and uses past issues as leverage, preventing progress and making him feel defined by his errors [16].
8. **She avoids doing things he enjoys together** [17]. She loses interest in his hobbies and spending quality time on shared activities, prioritizing others, which makes him feel unimportant and diminishes intimacy [17, 18].

Psychotherapist Moshe Ratson states that fading intimacy leads to frustration, resentment, loneliness, and a loss of joy [21].
11. **She avoids making future plans** [22]. A sudden disinterest in discussing future plans, like vacations or starting a family, indicates she no longer respects him or values creating a life with him. This can make him feel unvalued, hopeless, and question the relationship's stability [22, 23].
